

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

1. Up-to-date immunization record **signed by M.D. must include:**

DPT – Age 1-6 years: 4 doses with one dose given on or after the 4th birthday OR any 5 doses.
Ages 7 years or older: 3 doses.

Tdap – For students born after 1/1/1997 and entering or attending Grade 6 or above –1 dose
A child is not required to have a Tdap dose until FIVE years after the last DTP/DTap or Td dose.

POLIO – Ages 1-6 years: 3 doses, with one dose given on or after the 4th birthday, OR any 4 doses.
Ages 7 years or older: 3 doses.

MEASLES – If born before 1/1/90: 1 dose of live measles-containing vaccine on or after the first birthday.
If born on or after 1/1/90: 2 doses of live measles-containing vaccine or one dose and lab evidence of immunity, preferably MMR (must be after 1st birthday and the two doses separated by at least one month)

MUMPS – 1 dose of live mumps-containing vaccine on or after the first birthday.

RUBELLA – 1 dose of live rubella-containing vaccine on or after the first birthday.

VARICELLA (Chicken Pox) – one dose after 1st birthday for students born on or after 1/1/98.
Laboratory evidence of immunity, parent or MD statement of previous varicella disease is acceptable.

HEPATITIS B

K-Grade 12: 3 doses

Ages 11-15 years: 2 doses of Hepatitis B Adolescent formulation **if not previously vaccinated with the 3 dose series.**

Meningococcal – If born after 1/1/97: and entering or attending Grade 6 or above – 1 dose
*This applies to students when they turn 11 years of age.

MANTOUX – (tuberculin skin test) for students coming from certain countries (The four-pronged Tine Test is **not** acceptable.)

2. Copy of birth certificate with official seal (not a hospital certificate)
3. Physical exam signed by M.D. completed 365 days or less prior to admission
4. Health History form (filled out by parents)
5. Dental visit 6 months or less prior to admission

***Records of the above requirements MUST BE COMPLETED AND APPROVED
by the school nurse no later than August 30th***

**NO STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL
WITHOUT SUBMITTING ITEMS 1-4.**

**These must be on file in the nurse's office in order to meet
NJ State requirements.**
